This summer we inaugurated a new student success cohort for men of color, MBK CONNECT. Based on President Obama's My Brother's Keeper framework to provide safe and supportive communities for young men of color, John Jay's MBK program is created around four pillars for success: academic excellence, community engagement & leadership, professional development and postgraduate planning, and health & wellbeing. Sixty-seven freshmen completed a course this summer while building lasting bonds of brotherhood they will bring with them as they start their college careers.
