

The Academic Integrity Office: Supporting Faculty

Provide consultation and advisement:

- How to talk to students about Academic Integrity, before violations occur.
- To report or not to report? How to evaluate potential violations.
- How to move smoothly through the Academic Integrity process.
- How to determine an appropriate academic penalty for proven violations.

Conduct Academic Integrity case reviews:

- Interview students and other relevant parties.
- Collect and review of all documentation pertaining to the case.
- Research past history of academic violation.
- Mediate between faculty and student, when appropriate.

Generate findings, recommendations and referrals:

- Development of recommendations and findings for faculty and students.
- Make referrals for further review by the Faculty Student Disciplinary Committee when appropriate.
