The grade of WA is not computed in the grade point average. WA grades may affect student eligibility for financial aid.
WU	—		Unofficial W		Unofficial W	If a student stopped attending or has never attended your course and a pre-marked "W" does not appear in the grade column, a "WU" grade should be assigned. AUD	-		Auditor		Auditor	A student must have requested the status of auditor at the start of the semester. If a student in your course officially applied for auditor's status, a grade of "AU" will appear in the grade column. This grade cannot be assigned by the instructor.
