#### Preliminary Team Chair Visit Next Week An Important Step in Our Middle States Reaccreditation

Next Monday, December 12, <u>Dr. Philip</u> <u>Rous</u>, the Chair of the Evaluation Team appointed by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education to assess how well John Jay meets the standards for reaccreditation, will be making his preliminary visit to the campus. Dr. Rous will be meeting with the President, the Self-Study Co-chairs Ned Benton, James Cauthen, and me, the Middle States Steering Committee, and the Financial and Strategic Planning Subcommittees.

The goal of his visit is to prepare us for what is ahead March 12-15, 2023 when the entire evaluation team will be on campus to ask follow-up questions about our Self-Study and to assess how well John Jay is meeting the <u>Seven</u> <u>Standards for Accreditation</u>.
