

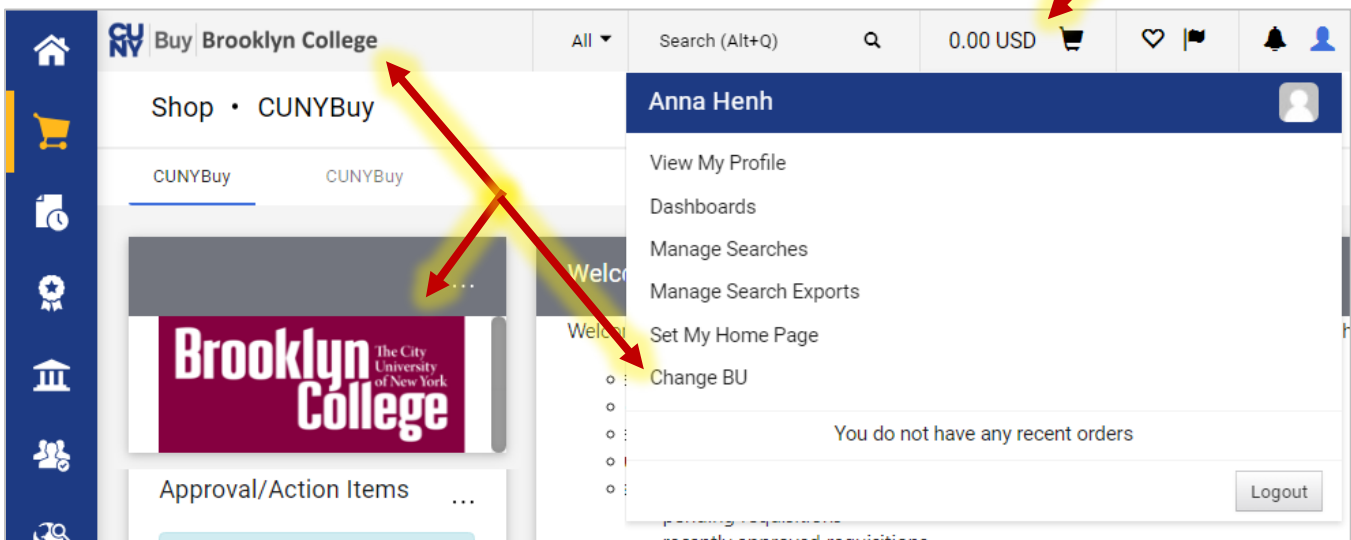
Creating a Marketplace Requisition

Creators can create a requisition for goods or services that are currently available on the Marketplace.

All requisitions for these suppliers must be created in the Marketplace. This ensures that CUNY receives the negotiated contract pricing.

Once a Creator has logged onto CUNYBuy, the following must be verified:

- The homepage displays the correct Business Unit. If it does not, change the Business Unit to the correct one before proceeding with any other tasks. You can change your Business Unit by clicking **User** icon in the top right corner and selecting the
- Ensure that the Cart is empty and at “0.00 USD”.



Create a Marketplace Requisition

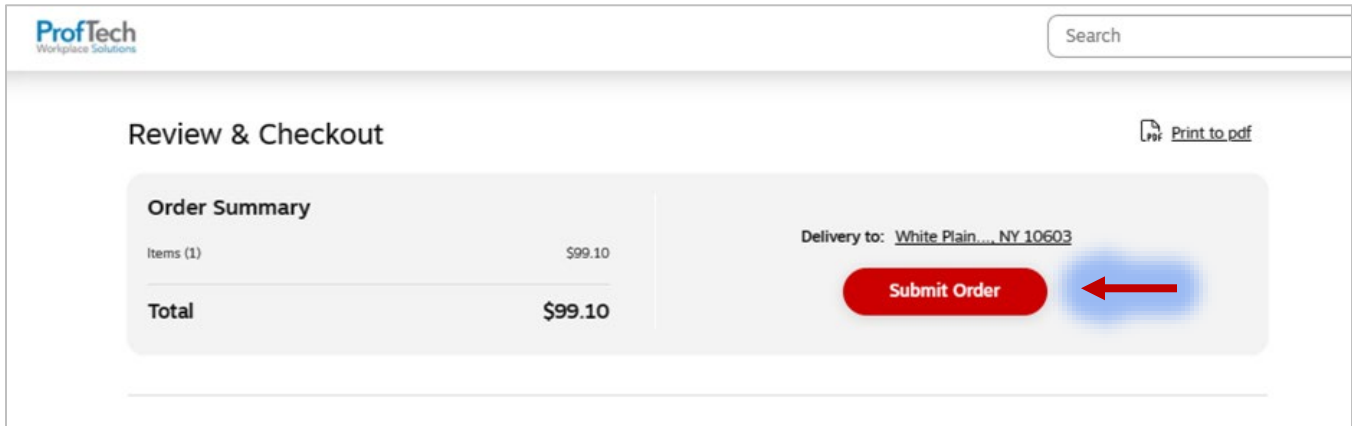
Scroll down to the **Marketplace** section of the page and click on the supplier that will provide the goods required. Clicking on the supplier tile will take you to the website of the supplier..



Each supplier's page will look different, so ensure that you follow the website navigation to add the needed items to your cart. When you have completed shopping, click on the **Cart** icon to proceed to checkout.

Any changes to the order – quantity, goods, adding or removing a line, etc. should be done at this time, prior to submitting the order.

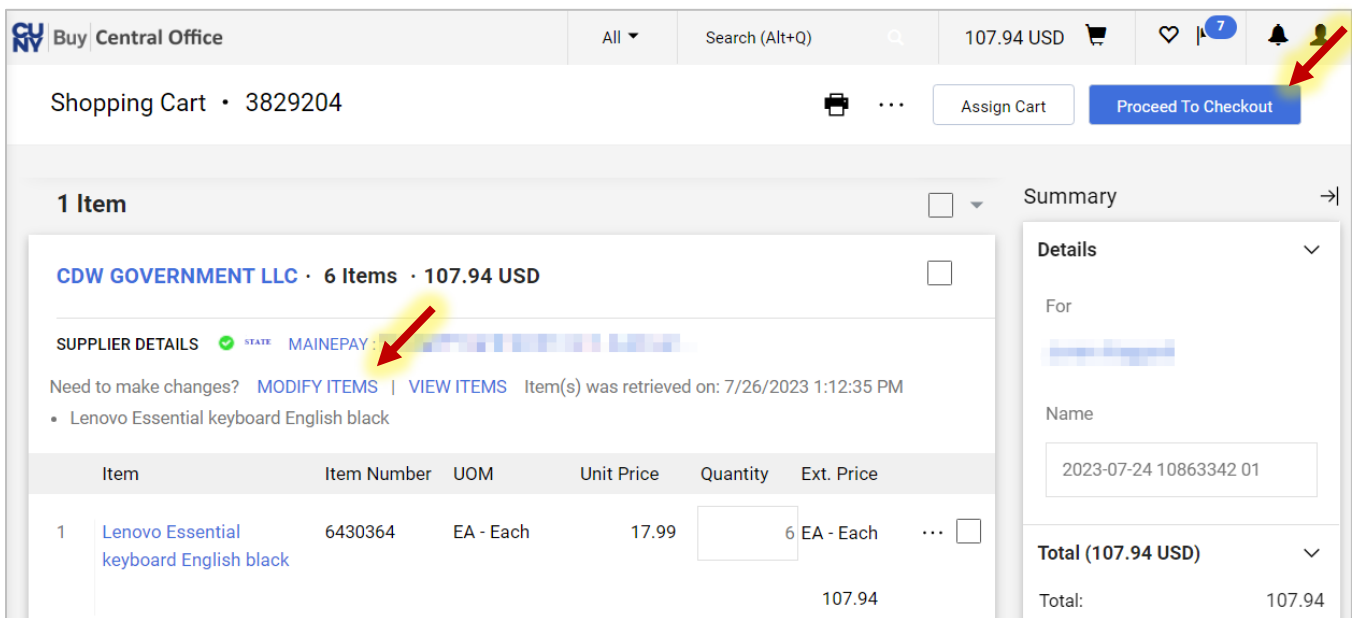
Click the **Submit Order** button. You will be returned to the **Shopping Cart** page in CUNYBuy.



Review the Shopping Cart and ensure that the items and quantities are correct.

Note: This is your last opportunity to make any changes to the contents of your cart. Once you proceed to checkout, you will not longer have the ability to modify the contents of your cart. To make changes, click the **Modify Items** link, which will take you back to the supplier website.

Click the **Proceed to Checkout** button to continue creating the requisition. You will be taken to the **Requisition** page.



The **Requisition** page will show the assigned requisition number at the top. On the right side of the **Requisition** page is the **Summary** section that lists the status of the requisition and any issues that needs to be addressed. These issues are also listed in the main document in red. You can address each issue by clicking the link in the **Summary** section or the **Required** flag in the main document.

Click the **Required: Justification** link to enter a justification for this requisition.

Enter your justification in the **Justification** field.

Do not check off the **Amount Only** checkbox for Market Requisitions– it will cause errors and your requisition will not move forward.

Click the **Save** button to continue.

The **Required: Justification** issue will no longer be listed in the **Summary** section.

Continue going through the issues under the **Summary** section. There are several key items to note and information that is required on this page. The box on the right – headed Draft, indicates that there is additional information to be provided on this page.

Click the **Edit** pencil icon next to the **Shipping** section and select one of the available addresses from the menu. Click the **Save** button.

Click the **Edit** pencil icon across from the **Billing** section. **lick** on the magnifying glass to see the options. Select the correct Accounts Payable address from the menu, then click the **Save** button.

Note: Billing address **must match** the business unit (BU). Therefore, you must never enter a default billing address in your profile. If a billing address does not match the BU, an error will result and your requisition will not move forward.

The next step is to enter the Accounting Codes (Chartfields) for this transaction. Click the **Edit** pencil icon or any of the **Required** flags in the Accounting Codes section.

Chartfields can be entered directly into the fields or selected using the dropdown menu and search icons. If you have previously created chartfield favorites, you can select them by clicking the **Code Favorites** heart icon and selecting from the dropdown menu.

Note: Talk to your business office regarding any questions about chartfield strings.

You can validate the chartfield string by selecting the **Recalculate/Validate** checkmark icon.

Click the **Save** button once you have entered and validated the chartfields.


When you return to the main page, the **Summary** section should have no additional corrections indicated. If it does, correct them at this time.

Use the **Comment** tab to enter support information for the requisition. Click the **New Comment** plus-sign icon to add a comment. Comments are only for internal CUNY review. All communications for requisitions should be entered into CUNYBuy for a complete record contained in one location, allowing any authorized person to derive information and status.

Different Chartfields For Multiple Line Requisitions


For multiple line requisitions, you **must** change the chartfield on each item line at checkout.

1. Navigate to the Summary tab of your requisition and scroll down to **Accounting Codes**.
2. You must start by entering the chartfield in the **Accounting Codes** section by clicking on the **Edit Accounting Codes Section** icon. This chartfield will be applied to all line items.



Important Reminders:

- Always verify/change if needed your Business Unit (BU) when you start a process.
- Always start with an empty cart.
- Once a marketplace requisition receives all approvals, it is automatically sourced to a PO.
- When searching for requisitions, if it is not found through the search function, check your cart. A requisition that does not pass budget will be automatically returned to your cart as a draft.
- Do not set a billing address as default. If the billing address does not match the BU, it will return an error and will not move forward.
- Never include any attachments for marketplace requisitions
- Do all communication via CUNYBuy. No communication related to the requisition should be done outside of CUNYBuy. This way the entire requisition record is complete and whole, allowing anyone with access to the requisition record to have all information needed to act on it.
