

Zoom Camera Policy:

In an effort to ensure an engaging and interactive learning experience during any online tutoring, workshop, or conversation group session, the Modern Language Center (*in collaboration with the MLL department*) has established a webcam policy that requires students to have their cameras turned on during scheduled class sessions. This policy is designed to foster active participation, enhance tutor-student engagement, and create a sense of learning community in the virtual environment. When students attend online tutoring sessions, it is expected that they enable their webcams throughout the session. Any student with their camera turned off will be considered non-participating and will receive a missed appointment for that session. We understand that there may be unique circumstances where webcam use may not be possible; in such cases, students are encouraged to communicate this situation with their tutors at the start of the session. However, regardless of webcam usage, all students are expected to participate and be engaged with their learning during all online sessions. The college values the privacy and comfort of all students and will maintain strict confidentiality in all tutoring sessions.
